My dear Joe:-

We are putting forward a bill at the next session of the Legislature asking for certain changes in the provision regarding our Law Course. To state the matter in the briefest possible form, we want to leave the present act as it is, but insert an option providing that a student may take three full years at college and one year in an office.

The bill is being put forward by P. Bercovitch and has been approved of by the Council of the Bar and by Laval. Athanase David is strongly in favour of it, and Ferron and the Prime Minister are well disposed.
