Note B.

The anterior fontanelle is the soft place in the front of an infant's head, just above the forehead.

Note C.

There is a class of mothers who give a great, even an excessive quantity of milk, who are not vigorous themselves, and whose nurslings do not thrive. The probability is that these women furnish a great quantity of milk of very poor quality. In some cases the infant is not able to take all the milk furnished by the mother, and yet it seems unsatisfied. We would advise such mothers to diminish the amount of liquid food or drink. Most, if not all, of such women drink a great deal of gruel, or beer, or some other
