

suaſion, the time of admiſſion, and the termination of the diſeaſe as far as it can be aſcertained.

3. Medicines and advice will be given to the poor, at every viſit of the attending Phyſician or Surgeon. All out-patients ſhall provide their own phials.

4. No out-patient ſhall loiter about the Hoſpital gate, or pre-miſes adjoining; they ſhall come directly to the place appointed to receive them, and as ſoon as they have received the advice and medicines, which may be conſidered neceſſary for them, they ſhall immediately leave the Hoſpital.

5. Any out-patient or patients who ſhall violate any of the rules or regulations of the Hoſpital, ſhall incur the penalty of diſmiſſal.

CHAPTER XVIII.

Of Vaccination.

1. On any of the days appointed by the Medical Board for inoculating the poor, gratis, any perſon or perſons, without the recommendation required for the admiſſion of patients to the Hoſpital, may preſent their children for inoculation.

2. The perſon or perſons who ſhall inoculate any children or other perſons, on any of the above ſtated days, ſhall register in a book belonging to the Hoſpital, kept for that purpoſe, the name, age, ſex, and religion of each and every individual ſo inoculated, the part of the body on which the inoculation has been performed, the date, progreſs and termination of each and every caſe.

3. Each and every perſon bringing a child or children for vaccination, ſhall depoſit two ſhillings and ſixpence as a pledge of returning once at leaſt with the child or children on a day fixed by the inoculator, that the appearance may be noted; non-compliance with this rule will incur the forfeiture of the depoſit, but upon due compliance with it, it will be returned.

CHAPTER XIX.

Of the Penalty of Receiving any Fee or Reward.

1. No Governor, Officer, or other perſon connected with the Montreal General Hoſpital, ſhall at any time preſume, under any pretence whatever, on pain of expulſion, to give to, or take from any tradesman, patient, ſervant, or any other perſon, or perſons, any fee, reward or gratuity of whatever kind, directly or indirectly.
