as the mond street is marked as the northern limits of the town and the open space around the Fort north of the town and between the Sandwich Road and the river, is marked as "Enrolled Pensioners' Grazing Ground." This plan comes down to the recollection of many of the older residents of Amherstburg, and here we leave the story for some local student to take up. These notes may be sufficient to start some one to write up the history of the town and to fill in the spaces with interesting personal sketches of the men and women, whose history would add much interest to a story that is thus roughly sketched:
