he has so practised, a statutory declaration made by himself and a ertificate from the proper officer showing that he is now in good standing at such Bar, and whether or not any application has to his knowledge ever been made or is pending at the time of his making such declaration to disbar him accompanied by a statutory declaration of some disinterested person not being a relative of the applicant verifying to the satisfaction of the Benchers the facts contained in his declaration, may apply to Convocation for enrollment as a Student at Law, and if after enquiry into the facts of the case Convocation so decides such person may be entered upon the books as a student, and after serving for a period of at least 6 months under articles with some advocate of the North-West Territorics and passing an examination to the satisfaction of the Benchers on the Statutes of the Dominion of Canada, the Ordinances of the North-West Territories and the practice of the Courts therein, and upon producing such other proofs of service and character as are required from students at law, and the Treasurers receipt for fees payable to the Society, may, if a British subject as required by the Legal Profession Ordinance be enrolled as an advocate. The fee payable by such person on application for enrollment shall be \$400.00.

- 42B. Applications from other foreign countries will be considered by Convocation and be granted under conditions similar to those contained in the proceeding Rule.
- 44A. Provided in all cases where advocates of the North-West Territories are required to pass an examination for admission to practice in the Province or Country of such applicant the applicant seeking enrollment under the provisions of Rule 42 shall be entitled to enrollment only after passing an examination such as is prescribed for enrollment from applicants from the United States.
- 44s. Provided further that such applicant shall before enrollment reside in and serve under articles in the North-West Territories for a period equal to that required of advocates of the North-West Territories seeking enrollment in the Province or Country of the applicant.
