

Line on No. . . . or column on No. . . . After the movement is completed, the named section will be halted, the section commanders placing their sections in the formations required.

155.—Being in Column of Sections, Right Leading, to Form Square.

Form—Square.—On the word SQUARE, the section commanders simultaneously command as follows :—

1st Section Commander : No. 1 section step short.

2nd Section Commander : No. 2 section advance in file from the right.

3rd Section Commander : No. 3 section advance in file from the left.

4th Section Commander : No. 4 section step short.

Forward.—When Nos. 2 and 3 sections arrive in their places they will step short. Upon the square being formed the Captain-General will then command FORWARD.

The colors take position in the centre of the square.

The square can be moved to the right, left or about, but before re-forming column of sections the square should be brought to its original formation.

156.—Being in Section Square to Reform Column of Sections and March to the Front.

Reform—Sections.—On the word SECTIONS, the section commanders will command as follows :—

1st Section Commander : No. 1 section step short.

2nd Section Commander : No. 2 section on the left form section, and when formed, step short.

3rd Section Commander : No. 3 section mark time (upon No. 2 section being formed), on the right form section, and when formed, step short.
