APPLICATIONS.

All applications for membership chall be made upon printed forms furnished by the Association, and if accepted, a certificate will be issued within thirty days from date of such acceptance.

MEMBERSHIP.

The payment of Eleven Dollars admits any one of sound body and mind, between the ages of 18 and 60 years, to all the benefits of the Association. If the application is not accepted the money is promptly returned to the applicant.
