NOTE TO TEACHERS.

This book will be found to cover the requirements of both the preliminary and advanced A.A. examinations and of the examination for Model School diplomas.

The examples have been carefully graded, beginning with easy, straightforward exercises, and leading up to others which require some thought and ingenuity besides the mere accurate manipulation of figures and tables.

It is hoped that the sections on mensuration and logarithms will be found especially useful, not only for preparing students for examinations in which a knowledge of mensuration and logarithms is required, but also as furnishing an instructive sequel to the higher parts of arithmetic.

No Teachers' Manual accompanies this book, as teachers of advanced work generally prefer to use their own methods. Answers to the examples will be found at the end of the book.
