scientific or practical knowledge in matters relating to the electrical industry and whose efforts and interests on behalf of said industry shall commend them to this Association. They shall be elected upon unanimous recommendation of the Executive Committee, approved by a two-thirds vote of this Association. They shall have all the privileges of Class A members except the right to vote, to hold elective office, and to attend the executive session.

Sec. 10.—Accredited representatives of Class A and D members, or Class B and E members are alone eligible to office or to the Executive Committee.

Sec. 11.-In case of a corporation, the membership shall attend in the name of the Company, and such Company shall have the right to be represented at any meeting of this Association by any one of its officers or directors, or by its regularly employed manager or superintendant. Each such Company member shall have one vote only on the election of officers and Executive Committee, and on all questions coming before exclusive meetings of representatives of Class A members, Class B members, Class D members and Class E members, which shall be designated as "Executive Sessions"

Sec. 12.—Every application for active or associate membership shall be made in writing to the Secretary, and must contain a signed agreement by the applicant to comply with the requirements of the Constitution, if elected. All applicants shall be referred to the Executive Committee, and if accepted by a majority vote, the applicant shall be cnrolled as a member and the application
