## Stage-Struck Girls Beware Advice of Police Officers

Answering Advertisements Appearing in Yankee Papers for Theatrical Help May Result Disastrously—Inspectors Stark and Archibald Seen.

## WHAT DOES STATUTE MEAN?

Case of City of Toronto Against Consumers' Gas Company is Narrowed Down.

CHARGED WITH MISAPPLYING FUNDS
