"The enemy's anti-aircraft defences were strong. At first the weather conlitions were good, but later became ery bad with rain, low clouds and a trong wind, rendering the return of ur machines most difficult.

"On Wednesday there was a slight mprovement in the weather on the tritish front, though dragging clouds, nd a very strong west wind made bservation and fighting over the enmy's lines difficult. One hundred and fity-four bombs were dropped during he day on the enemy's billets, twelve eavy bombs on an airdrome near ourirai and 71 others on German opps in trenches and in the open.

"At times the fighting was severe, our hostile machines were downed by ir airplanes; one was shot down by ir infantry, and three other machines ere brought down out of control. Six our machines are missing."


