I had an interview with the Chief of Fisher River lately and he expressed himself as satisfied with the work done by Mr J. K. Mclean D.L.S. on his Reserve last summer. He also understands that the 160 acres where Peter Murdoch has his house and improvements will constitute if granted by the Department a part of his Reserve.

I discussed this matter with Peter Murdoch and he fully understands that this land forms a part of the Reserve in common but wishes to continue in occupancy of the same and to this the Chief and Council are agreed. There can therefore be no misunderstanding on this point.
