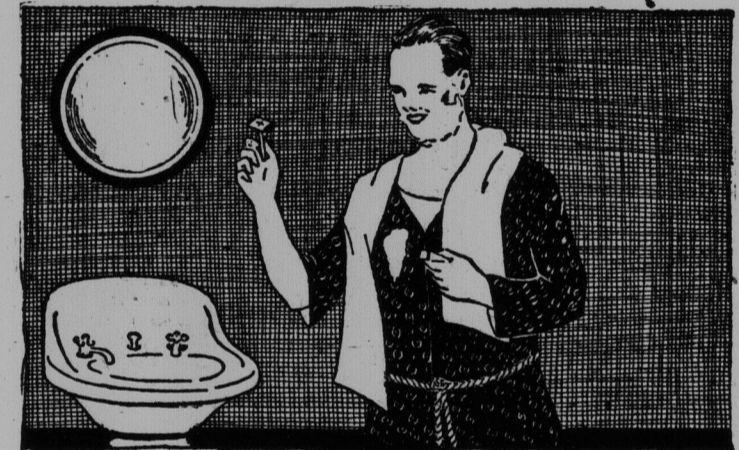

TEACHERS' PENSIONS.
Under the superannuation system which went into force in September, 1920, the teachers of Ohio pay four per cent. of their salaries (though in no case to exceed four per cent. of \$2,000). In addition to superannuation and disability allowances, there is a provision that teachers leaving the service and not eligible for pension receive back all their payments with four per cent. interest, compounded annually. Superannuation schemes are now in general operation in progressive states, provinces and countries. Our Ontario fund is making good progress, according to the report of the commissioners, and another five years should enable the commission to provide more generous allowances than were at first anticipated.
