ANOTHER G. T. P. RUMOR The Grand Trunk Railway Company has exchanged some high-lying land which it owned at Portland, Maine, for a tract near the water front, at the east end of the city. Commenting on this the Montreal Witness says:— "This deal is looked upon in well informed circles as possessing great significance. In view of the possibility of the failure of the Grand Trunk plans to reach tidewater at Providence, R. I., and at Boston, the railway, it is believed, is preparing to make Portland, its present winter port, into its big Atlantic terminal, for both the Grand Trunk and the Grand Trunk Pacific systems after the close of navigation. If this is correct, it will mean the expenditure of some millions of dollars at Portland, and the making of the town into one of the chief railway terminals on the Atlantic seaboard."

DEALING WITH CRIMINALS Mayor Harrison of Chicago believes that the prison parole system has been overworked. He expresses his own belief that this system is responsible for the wave of crime in Chicago, and points out that during December sixty-seven prisoners were released on parole and sent to Chicago. The list included men who had committed serious crimes, and the mayor believes that some of them could tell the story, if they chose, of some of the crimes committed since their release.

The extent of our military expenditure, aside from the North Sea Armageddon subsidy, should be such provision as would bring us wireless messages concerning the manner in which our mercenaries bore themselves under fire. 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THE FAILURE OF BONAR LAW There will be less disposition in Canada, hereafter to boast that Mr. Bonar Law is a Canadian. As the leader of a party in the British parliament and in the country, he has openly encouraged rebellion against the authority of parliament. He has not only predicted that Home Rule in Ireland would be met by rebellion in Ulster, but, speaking with all the authority of the leader of the Unionist party, he declared that "no rebellion would be better justified." Proceeding in his wild assertions he said further:— "The men of Ulster are ready to give up their lives at the hands of British soldiers. If they shoot down a hundred in Belfast, 2,000 will be ready next day to share their fate."
