30. That rule 256, be repealed because it is inconvenient, and the above privileges are much greater than it gives.

31. That a Minister in each District be appointed by Conference, as General Missionary Committee Delegate, who shall visit any of the Missions in his Districts and Circuits when required, to advise and assist, under the direction of the Missionary and General Committee.

32. That the Missionary Committee shall have power so to change the time of holding the Mission Quarterly Meetings as to enable the Missionary Secretary or the District Delegates to visit them; and that these officers shall be members of the Quarterly Meetings they

33. That all Missionary Deputations neglecting their appointments, be reported to the Distirict Meeting by the Superintendents where the omission occurs.
