

An Act to divide the Municipality of St. Gabriel de Valcartier into two separate Municipalities.

WHEREAS certain of the inhabitants of the Municipality of St. Preamble.

Gabriel de Valcartier, in the County of Quebec, have by their petition represented that those resident in that part of the said Municipality, which is situate on the North-west side of the river Jacques Cartier, suffer serious inconveniencies, and that the Municipal Law cannot be effectually carried out, by reason of the great superficial extent of the said Municipality of St. Gabriel de Valcartier, and the fact of the whole being under the control of one local Council, and have prayed that an Act may be passed to divide the same into two separate Municipalities for all Municipal and School purposes; and it is expedient to grant their prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Upon, from, and after, the first day of January next, all that part of the said Municipality of St. Gabriel de Valcartier, in the County of Quebec, which is situate to the North-west of the river Jacques Cartier shall be erected into and constituted under the name of the Municipality of St. Gabriel West, a separate Local, and School Municipality, and shall have all the rights, powers and privileges of a separate Municipality under the Lower Canada Municipal Act of 1800; and also of a separate School Municipality, under the School Laws of Lower Canada. Municipality of St. Gabriel West erected.

II. The remaining portion of the said Municipality of St. Gabriel de Valcartier shall, from the date aforesaid, be a separate Municipality, with the like rights, powers and privileges, and under the name of St. Gabriel de Valcartier. Municipality of St. Gabriel de Valcartier.

III. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
