

MEMORANDUM.

Ottawa, December 29, 1909.

To the Deputy Minister-

In compliance with request contained in your memo. of the 20th ultimo, I beg to submit a statement showing the surrendered lands on the different reserves in the West, which were put up for sale by public auction and were not disposed of, giving in detail the quarter sections on each reserve, the area and upset price.
