To corroborate What I have just Stated, I take the liberty of Lubjoining to this letter, the Certificate of our benerable ellipsionary M' Marcouf, which is not equivocal: That Gentleman is a better Sudge than the Chiefs and members of the Council, and Knows more what is duitable to them, than they do themselves. L'elso Suljoin a Copy of my Commission, of the general over dated 30th Sanuary 1828, and of my then document acquitations VVX. I hope you will find They Do not accompany every thing as it should be. the paper I forbear laying any thess on the unfeeling Conduct which distinguished my appointed in their proceedings;
