

Cannot find in the letter in question  
 any authority whatever for diverting  
 the payment of his Indian money from  
 Latham to Sage, and I am to inform  
 you to call on Mr. Latham to produce  
 Latham's written authority for the pay-  
 ments made by him to Sage amounting  
 to Eighty nine Dollars and twenty cents  
 (89<sup>00</sup>), and also to require him to  
 show the authority under which he  
 received the money and to procure  
 witness in writing that he did not  
 do so on Latham's account and under  
 his instructions. Unless these require-  
 ments of the Department are complied  
 with at once the future monthly  
 payments which will become due to  
 Sage will be withheld and paid to  
 Latham until his claim is satisfied.
