2. General Henry presented a memorandum addressed to Air Vice Marshal Curtis giving details of the personnel which the Air Transport Command plan to leave at Edmonton, Whitehorse and Fort Nelson when the bases of the Northwest Staging Route are vacated. A copy of this memorandum appears as an Appendix to the Journal.

3. On the subject of probable United States requirements on the Alaska Highway Landlines System, General Henry presented a memorandum addressed to the Secretary of the Canadian Section, a copy of which is attached as an Appendix to the Journal. It was stated by Air Vice Marshal Curtis that these requirements could be met by the Royal Canadian
