

defence of freedom and human rights. On such a foundation of unity of purpose and of effort, free peoples may well hope to build an enduring new world order.

"And I saw a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and the rewas no more sea... and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor erring, neither shall there be any more pain; for the former things are passed away."

A new heaven and a new earth -- Are not these, in very truth, what we seek today? A heaven to which men, and women and little children no longer will look in fear, but where they may gaze again in silent worship, and in thankfulness for the benediction of the sun and the rain; an earth no longer scarred by warfare and torn by greed, but where the lowly and the humble of all races, may work in ways of pleasantness, and walk in paths of peace.

And the sea no longer will be the scene of conflict nor harbor any menace; it too will gladden the hearts of men as it unites, in friendly intercourse, the nations of the world.

This new heaven, this new earth is the vision which, at this time of war, unites, inspires, and guides, Britain, Canada, the other nations of the British Commonwealth, and the United States. No lesser vision will suffice to gain the victory. No lesser service to humanity, will hold the faith, and win the gratitude of mankind.

It is this new world order which our honoured guest, Mr. Wendell Wilkie, is joining with others to help to create.
