Editor, *Grain*:—As expressed in Sir Wilfrid's speeches and by Mr. Sifton's letter I understand that we have little or no hope for a reduction of the tariff in farm implements. In that case why not ask Sir Wilfrid to give us a commission to regulate the rates, and it worked well. Now as we are being charged fair more over and above a reasonable price for farm implements than the railways ever charged over and above a fair price for freighting it seems only fair that we ask for the same remedy for a greater evil. A commission working along the same lines as the railway commission would cause the implement combine to sell us the said implements at a greatly reduced price and still leave them a good having profit. I think by tinkering with the tariff we might get a reduction of duty but what good would that do if the root of the evil, the implement combine, is allowed to put up the price as they like afterwards. We certainly need a remedy and I think that efforts aimed to cause the combine to sell their wares at a fair price will do more good than if the duty were all taken off.

**NO POLITICAL FLAVOR**

Editor *Grain*:—I noticed in your paper a few weeks ago a letter written by Edgar W. Frost, Clareholm, dealing with meetings held at different points (MacLeod included). Mr. Frost accuses our vice-president, W. J. Tregillus, of having in company with members of parliament and of giving these meetings a political flavor. I know at the time I read Mr. Frost's letter that he was wrong, because I was present at the MacLeod meeting and had read the reports of the other meetings referred to, but knowing Mr. Frost as I do, I thought he must have been misinformed and that when he found out the truth he would publish it. I have seen no further word from Mr. Frost.

As far as the MacLeod meeting goes there was not a member of parliament on the platform nor in the audience. Even the farmers' candidate who is an independent was not present.

Mr. Tregillus' subject was the necessity of organization and co-operation amongst the producers. He referred briefly to the good example the farmers of this constituency had set in bringing out their own candidate who was favorable to their interests and said we did not want any hide-bound party politicians. Where is your political flavor? I do not quite understand what Mr. Frost means by political flavor. If he means that Mr. Tregillus urges the farmers to get into politics and work and support any man who is true and favorable to these interests, I do not see where he would be unconstitutional if he did so.

One of the by-laws of our constitution reads, "To endeavor to secure legislation relating to the farmers' interests and equitable rates of transportation." How can we do this but through our vote? This is the only weapon we have to act
