CAP. I.

An ACT to consolidate and amend the Laws rela-
ting to STATUTE LABOUR, and the Expenditure
of Public Moneys on the Highways.

[Passed *April 4th*, 1843.]

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to consoli-
date and amend the several Laws now in
force, regulating the performance of Statute Labour
on the Highways : Be it therefore enacted, by the
Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That
from and after the passing of this Act, an Act passed
in the Third year of the Reign of His late Majesty
King William the Fourth, intituled *An Act to*
