SOCIALIST GROUP DEFINES ATTITUDE

EXPRESSES AGREEMENT WITH ITS AIMS AND BINDS THE PARTY

Paris France June 30.—The program of the Socialist group in the Chamber defining its attitude and intentions has been published in L'Humanite.

Beginning by pointing out the necessity for the support of Socialists in the country if the action of the party in parliament is to be efficacious the declaration goes on to refer to the Basle interparliamentary conference. It expresses perfect agreement with its aims and binds the Socialist party to do all in its power to make effective the two in-

terparliamentary meetings which are to take place simultaneously in October next both in France and in Germany.

It congratulates members of the Reichstag upon their declaration that in proportion as a liberal regime is granted in Alsace-Lorraine will it become possible to bring about a rapprochement between Germany and France. The armed nation plan of defence the return to the two years period of service fiscal reform with a graduated tax on incomes and capital and controlled declaration electoral reform and the introduction of proportional representation social reform including the weekly holiday and the dejection of a large proportion of the income tax returns to the provision of insurance benefits for the working classes all find their place in the Socialist declaration which terminates by pointing to the necessity of the reform of the Senate and the suppression of its veto.
