Revenue and Expenditure for Eleven Months Ending May 31.

OTTAWA, June 7.—The statement of revenue and expenditure for the eleven months ending May 31st last, was is sued by the department of finance to day. The revenue for the eleven months was \$46,571,324 as against \$45, 102 144 or increase for ensure them

agy. The revenue for the eleven months was \$46,571,234 as against \$45,-107,144, or increase for current fiscal year of \$1,464,140. The revenue com-pared with the expenditure shows a surplus of \$10,045,036, or in round fig-ures \$11,000,000. This ison ordinary ex-penditure. If capital expenditure, which amounted to \$8,731,242, is de-ducted, there is still left a surplus of one million and a half dollars. How ever, it is not expected that this or any amount will[®] be deducted from the public debt dur-ing the present year, although there will be a good surplus over the ex-penditure on ordinary account. In regard to the revenue ti may be said that there was an in-crease from all resources, except cus-toms, which shows a very slight re-duction of about \$60,000.
