

LONDON-WHAT IT IS

The declaration of London was adopted at a conference of the chief naval powers held 1908, until February, 1909, in the Rules of Priso in naval warfare. The object was to draw up a definite code, fol-lowing the precedent of the declaration of Paris of 1856 for the purposes of the inter-national prize court to be established in accordance with one of the conventions of the second Hague conference of 1907.
