WEEKLY REVIEW OF THE MARKET

London, Wednesday, Nov. 17.

Twenty loads of hay were offered at the market; sales were fairly brisk, at \$12 per ton for choice, while inferior and second quality sold at \$10 to \$11 per ton.

Oats were firm, at \$1.20 and \$1.22 per cwt. Barley is more plentiful, and sells at \$1.10 to \$1.15 per cwt.

WHEAT REVIEW.
Farmers have no reason to complain of the market, as there is a moderately brisk demand and prices are considered high. In some lines, such as hay and oats, prices may not be as high as a year ago, but on the whole there is little room for complaint.

Grain—There is no change in the price of wheat here, which sells at \$8.00 per bushel; the market is firm and prices are likely to go higher. Oats are in good demand and prices are firm, at \$1.18 to \$1.22 per cwt; the supply is not large. Barley is scarce, at \$1.15 per cwt.

Hay and Straw—Hay sells at \$12 and \$12.50 per ton for choice; inferior, \$10 per ton, and second quality at \$11 per ton; the demand is good and prices are firm and freely sold. Straw is being sent out in large quantities and sales are brisk at \$7 and \$7.50 per ton.

Butter and Eggs—Butter is firm, at 24c for crocks and 25c for pound rolls, in wholesale lots. Eggs are higher in price; strictly fresh-laid sell at 25c per dozen whole, and 26c retail; cold storage and candied stock are quoted at 25c per dozen for crate lots.

Potatoes—The market is steady at last week's quotations; sales are on the slow side, at 55c per bag; but there is a good deal of five to ten-bag lots; some loads that were not up to the standard sold at 55c and 56c per bag.

Apples—The market is moderately brisk for choice stock, which sells at \$1.10 per bag and \$2.50 per barrel; the inferior grades, which form a large percentage of the offerings, are slow at 10c to 15c per bag and about \$1.50 per barrel.

Poultry—The dealers claim that there is a large quantity being offered at present, and as very little is being sent out of the city, trade is slow; the dealers quote the following prices: Old fowl, 5c per lb alive, 7c dressed; chickens, 8c per lb alive, 10c dressed; turkeys, 10c per lb alive, 12c dressed; ducks, 7c per lb alive, 10c dressed; geese, 8c to 9c per lb dressed.

Dressed Hogs—Prices are higher than a week ago, as sales are mostly at \$5.25 per cwt for hogs which dress about 150 lbs; deal on the weather.

Live Hogs—A couple of carloads were shipped from here on Monday at \$5.00 per cwt for select and \$4.75 for fat sows; the buyers are of the opinion that at least the same price will prevail for next Monday's shipment. It is a strange thing that the price of live hogs in such important centres as Chicago and Buffalo are on the decline, while here they are considerably higher, and, of course, we have to compete with American bacon in the English markets. Small pigs sell at \$4 to \$5 per pair.

Butchers' Meats—Colder weather will keep trade up in this line; there is a fair demand for the offerings at present; beef sells at \$5.50 to \$6.00 per cwt; veal, \$5.50 to \$6.00 per cwt; lamb mostly at 30c per lb by the carcass; pork and bacon for forequarters and 10c for hindquarters.

Hides—There is no change in prices; the market is firm, at 50c for No. 1, 45c for No. 2, and 40c for No. 3 grades of cow hides; calfskins sell at 11c per lb.

Wool—Quiet, at 15c to 16c for raw and washed and 7c to 8c for unwashed.
