








The policy of the Dominion govern-ment in respect to immigration has ai-ways discriminated against the Eastern Provinces and British Columbia, having been, in fact, little else than a real es-inte proposition on a large scale. Its principal object has been to get settlers on the great vacant areas owned by the Dominion and tying between the Red river and the Rocky mountains. There has been no particular change in this and perhaps such a policy was fully justifiable, while the immense possibil-ities of the region referred to remained.

With common and skilled labor ranging from \$5 to \$10 per day, the rebajiding of San Francisco will prove a costly operation and one in which out-side capital will not be eager to em-
