The public school board met last evening, Mr. E. Galley in the chair. All the members were present. Communications were read from Mr. Lewis, head master of Dufferin school, calling attention to the damage done to the school by the headmaster of the different schools, asking for an increase of salary for the reasons that their salaries were barely sufficient to cover ordinary expenses, and that after their long and arduous work, they were left to purchase literature, and that in the shape of good salaries in the school system.

Workingmen Waking Up

AN ENTHUSIASTIC MEETING IN TEMPERANCE HALL LAST NIGHT.

J. N. Carter and Samuel H. Heakel, both members of the Parliament House, were the main speakers at the meeting.

A mass meeting of workmen called by the Toronto Trades and Labor Council was held last night in Temperance hall for the purpose of assisting in the nomination of candidates for the Ontario legislature and maturing plans for the coming contest.

The meeting was very large, the hall being crowded to the doors while the enthusiasm displayed by those present far exceeded a sharp contest for the Toronto seats if not a sweeping success for the workmen's candidates.

The chair was occupied by Mr. Thos. Moore in his opening remarks, sketched the platform of the party stating that they were to take a new departure from the old lines of party politics and select two men from their own ranks to contest the two constituencies of East and West Toronto.

In their selection they did not pretend to have reached perfection, but as their names were of themselves a guarantee that they stand their ground from having had practical experience of what the needs of the workmen really are. (Applause.)

The following nominations were submitted to the meeting and unanimously supported:

West Toronto—J. N. Carter nominated by Thos. Moore seconded by Alfred Oakley.

East Toronto—Samuel H. Heakel nominated by Mr. John Armstrong seconded by Mr. John Giblin.

Mr. Carter, nominating the meeting at considerable length, held that the labor should and ought to be represented in the halls of legislation. It should be represented, not by those who profess to care for the interests of those who have little or nothing in common with the working class, but by those who are in direct sympathy with that class by being members of it.
