The Late Donald Brock. Editor World: It was with deep regret I read your account of the sad accident which deprived the late Donald Brock of his life. There were one or two inaccuracies, however, which I wish to correct so as to avoid any misunderstanding which might arise on the part of those who are not so well acquainted with the family as I am. You stated that he had a sister and mother who was dead; that "the whereabouts of the latter was unknown." This is very misleading. Mr. Brock's father and mother are both dead; his mother died about 20 years ago and his father about six years ago. He had two brothers and two sisters. Mr. Donald Brock returned to the city from the far southwest just a year ago in order to look after the details in connection with the burial of his brother John, who, by the way, also met his death by a painful accident. There are still living one brother and two sisters. The brother, the Rev. George H. Brock, is engaged as a missionary of the American Baptist Foreign Mission Board among the Telugu of India, while the two sisters reside in the city. One is unmarried, the other being the wife of Mr. Jesse Dunn, the well-known cattle buyer.
