DIVING FOR 2100,000.

The English diver and Captain R. F. Stevens, Lloyd's diver, have just returned from the Island of Grand Canary after raising a sum of no less than 200,000.

This amount was lying submerged 155 feet about a mile from the southwest limit of the Island of Grand Canary. The treasure was found down about two years ago in a brand new Spanish steamer, called the *Alphonso XII*. The steamer had on board 1,000,000 worth of Spanish dollars on their way to Cuba. The insurance on the money was effected at Lloyd's, and was paid over to the insurers after the vessel foundered.

After a lapse of over a year Capt. R. F. Stevens and three English divers were sent out to Grand Canary to try and recover the sunken treasure. They succeeded in bringing up to the surface a quantity of the value of 21,000 each, but the truth is that they had not a single dollar to show for their trouble.
