Peptogenic Milk Powder

For Normal Infants

ILK prepared with Peptogenic Milk Powder is primarily designed for the nutrition of the normal infant. This feed has proteids, carbohydrates, fat and mineral constituents in the proportions in which these substances are normally present in mothers' milk; further, the proteids are soluble and noncoagulable like the albuminoids of mothers' milk.

This conversion of the proteids of cows' milk in the preparation of a food for infants is peculiar to the Peptogenic Milk Powder and process; there is no other realisable means by which the same purpose can be effected.

The method is not simply one of dilution and addition, as with most of the mixtures in ordinary use. It gives first a quantitative, then a qualitative, adjustment of cows' milk to the standard of mothers' milk. It makes milk available for the feeding of an infant during the period of growth and development when milk is the natural and essential food.
