

Armando Calderón Sol
President of the Republic of El Salvador

Born in San Salvador on June 24, 1948, Armando Calderón earned a doctorate in jurisprudence and social sciences from the University of El Salvador in 1977. Mr. Calderón was one of the founding members of the Alianza Republicana Nacionalista party. He was elected to Congress in 1985.

Mr. Calderón was elected mayor of San Salvador, the capital of El Salvador, for two consecutive terms, in 1988 and 1991. He was elected President of the Republic of El Salvador in April 1994.

Mr. Calderón is married to Elizabeth Aquirra. They have three sons.
