

1.2. Departmental SME Contribution

Departmental subject matter experts are essential to the work of CFSI and to the learning of Departmental employees. They provide input into the content of learning activities and they are often an integral part of the delivery, either as panellists or to facilitate course modules to share their knowledge and experience.

Although it is difficult to estimate the amount of time Departmental personnel contribute to the content of learning activities or their preparation time when presenting a specific topic, we have estimated their time in class to be the following by Program.
