2. If so, (a) what were the amounts of each tender; (b) to whom was the contract awarded?

3. Were tenders submitted in March of 1957 for the construction of the extension of the Mackenzie highway to the Mackenzie river?

4. If so, (a) what were the amounts of each tender; (b) to whom was the contract awarded?

5. How many miles of road have been completed up to the end of December, 1957, on the Yellowknife-Fort Rae section, and what amount was paid to the contractor?

6. How many miles of road have been completed on the Mackenzie highway extension to the Mackenzie river up to December 31, 1957, and how much was paid to the contractor?
