them. We need goals, we need timetables, and we need effective enforcement for this legislation. I urge this government to bring in those kinds of sanctions.

It is ironic that today this report is tabled. It is ironic because in this House we are debating back to work legislation. Part of that back to work legislation is dealing with women hospital workers who have already supposedly won pay equity. These women—the majority of these hospital workers are women—are demanding pay equity and they are not receiving it from this government.

I urge the government to deal fairly with all of these groups in society and to bring in effective measures for employment equity.
