

universities in those provinces are prescribed as far as Medical Graduates are concerned. that is of recent date and does not affect those now registered. I was interviewed on this problem in Georgetown Demerara but was not in a position to say anything.

McGill Graduates have been very kind to us and seemed glad to receive us as messengers of Remembrance to them.

There have been enquiries re Studies in McGill and I tried with Mrs Keith's help to direct enquirers to proper departments in McGill. Apart from the question of McGill desiring students from the West Indies - it strikes me it would be a very fine gesture to the Islands if a Scholarship could be established for Agriculture - Engineering or Biology. Mr I B McCauley might be sympathetic to such a fund.

We may pass through Montreal on our return and would be glad if you cared to see us to add to anything I have suggested. I have said nothing about the Cruise itself - that can wait. We appreciate our connection with McGill in this particular task as in all others.
