in farming operations before purchasing, and are willing to pay for such information;

And whereas the farmers of the County of Welland have been respectfully asked to forward their names and addresses, who are willing to take pupils and give instructions, to the clerk of this corporation;

And whereas the said council has instructed the clerk to forward such names and addresses to the Minister of Agriculture from time to time:

Your memorialists therefore humbly pray that you will be pleased to receive the names as forwarded from time to time, and cause steps to be taken to have other counties in the Province of Ontario to forward similar information, and that the whole be compiled in book form and forward same to immigration agents in foreign countries for distribution.

Your memorialists believing this means will give an opportunity to the class above referred to in getting reliable information, and thereby increasing the numbers of desirable immigrants to the Province of Ontario.

And your memorialists, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
