Salaries Act R.S., c. 243; 1968-69, c. 28, s. 97	The <i>Public Service Rearrangement and Transfer of Duties Act</i> is amended by adding thereto the following section: “4. Where a Minister of a department, a Minister of State or a Minister without Portfolio to whom any powers, duties or functions have been transferred by name pursuant to this Act dies or otherwise ceases to be a Minister of the Crown, those powers, duties or functions may be transferred to another Minister of the Crown as though the Minister had not died or otherwise ceased to be a Minister of the Crown.” Section 4 is amended (a) by substituting “The Minister of the Environment” for “The Minister of Fisheries and Forestry”; and (b) by adding thereto “The Postmaster General . . . 15,000”
Senate and House of Commons Act R.S., c. 249; 1968-69, c. 28, s. 98	Paragraphs 14(a) and 14(b) are repealed and the following substituted therefor: “(a) holds an office for which a salary is provided in section 4 or 5 of the <i>Salaries Act</i> and receives that salary, or (b) is a Minister of State, other than a Minister of State referred to in section 5 of the <i>Salaries Act</i> , or a Minister without Portfolio and receives a salary in respect of that position,”
Territorial Sea and Fishing Zones Act 1964-65, c. 22; 1966-67, c. 25, s. 45	Section 6 is amended by substituting the “Minister of the Environment” for the “Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources”.
