"4. Where a Minister of a department, a Minister of State or a Minister without Portfolio to whom any powers, duties or functions have been transferred by name pursuant to this Act dies or otherwise ceases to be a Minister of the Crown, those powers, duties or functions may be transferred to another Minister of the Crown as though the Minister had not died or otherwise ceased to be a Minister of the Crown."

Section 4 is amended

- (a) by substituting "The Minister of the Environment" for "The Minister of Fisheries and Forestry"; and
- (b) by adding thereto "The Postmaster General .. 15,000"

Paragraphs 14(a) and 14(b) are repealed and the following substituted therefor:

- "(a) holds an office for which a salary is provided in section 4 or 5 of the Salaries Act and receives that salary, or
- (b) is a Minister of State, other than a Minister of State referred to in section 5 of the Salaries Act, or a Minister without Portfolio and receives a salary in respect of that position,"

Section 6 is amended by substituting the "Minister of the Environment" for the "Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources".
