An Act to amend the Dominion Elections Act, 1900.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :-

20 his employees are engaged in labour, any handbill or placard containing any threat, notice or information, that if any particular ticket or candidate is elected or defeated, work in his place or establishment will cease in whole or in part, his establishment will be closed up, or the wages of his employees will
