

## THE SENATE OF CANADA

### BILL J<sup>16</sup>.

An Act to incorporate The Provident Assurance Company.

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:— 5

Incorporation.

**1.** Honourable Alphonse Raymond, industrialist, Jean Raymond, industrialist, both of the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, and Etienne Crevier, manager, of the city of Outremont, in the province of Quebec, together with such persons as become shareholders in the company are incorporated under the name of The Provident Assurance Company, and in French, La Prevoyance Compagnie d'Assurances, hereinafter called "the Company". 10

Provisional directors.

**2.** The persons named in section 1 shall be the provisional directors of the Company. 15

Capital stock.

**3.** The capital stock of the Company shall be one million dollars, divided into shares of ten dollars each.

Subscription before general meeting.

**4.** The amount to be subscribed before the general meeting is called for the election of directors shall be five hundred thousand dollars. 20

Head office.

**5.** The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec.
