

for Our Assent thereto; And whereas, in pursuance of the authority in Him vested under and by virtue of a certain Instrument or Commission issued by Our Governor of Our said Province in that behalf, bearing date at Monklands, in Our said Province, on the said Thirtieth day of May, assigning, deputing, substituting and appointing the said Deputy Governor to exercise, perform and execute, during the pleasure of Our said Governor, certain of the powers, functions and authorities of the said Governor, and amongst others, specially to reserve the said Bill for the signification of Our pleasure thereon, Our said Deputy Governor then and there reserved the said Bill for the signification of such pleasure, as in the discretion of Our said Governor it was lawful to do under and in pursuance of the authority vested in Our said Governor by a certain Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the Session held in the third and fourth years of Our Reign, intituled, *An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada*. Now KNOW YE, that the aforesaid Bill, intituled, *An Act to incorporate the Toronto, Simcoe and Lake Huron Union Rail-way Company*, having been laid before Us in Council, on the Thirtieth day of July, now last past, We have been pleased to Assent to the same; And We do by these presents, and according to the provisions of the said Act of Parliament of the United
