Sir,

Permit me to refer you to my letter of the 30 January last in reply to one from the Department dated the 4th of the same month No 99258, relative to the public passing on the reserve and to ask you, what decision the department has come to, with regard to the "proposed road" mentioned in a former correspondence; the public having again, for some weeks past, begun to circulate on the said "proposed road" and the Indians ~~not~~ made on both sides of the road not being disposed to suffer any longer the damages and depredations which may be caused again by the public making use of this road which is very narrow, nor will they in future allow the whites to pass with
