Melanson with other boys had been swimming in the river during the afternoon, and while negotiating a stretch of water near some logs appeared to tire and went under a log Horace Stout, who was one of his companions, went to his assistance and Melanson caught him by the leg and was being towed toward the shore when his hold relaxed and he sank. Stout shouted for help and soon Clarence Green rushed to the place and brought the boy to the shore. He tried first aid methods but without avail. Meanwhile a summons had been sent for a doctor and Dr. D. V. Davidson, of Manawagonish Road soon arrived. He said the boy was dead and nothing could be done for him.

Dr. F. L. Kenney, the coroner, was also notified. He viewed the body and pronounced it a case of accidental drowning and decided that an inquest was not necessary.


