> AT BREAK OF DAY Chekiang Army Strengthens Line and Retains Newly

Won Positions. CHANG CONFIDENT

Claims Success North of Pekin With Big Seizure of Munitions.

Shanghai, Sept. 20 (1 p. m.) -In an engagement that started at daybreak reinforced Chekiang troops on the front between the Shanghai-Nanking railway line and Kaiping pushed the invading Kiangsu forces back, strengthened their line, and retained positions near Hwangtu, 15 miles west of here. The artillery duel lasted all morning. The headquarters of the Chekiang army claims gains along the rail-

way around Hwangtu.

Chang Claims Gain. Tokio, Sept. 20.—In a commique issued at Mukden, Chang Tso-lin, the Manchurian leader, claims decisive successes over the forces of the Federal Government of Pekin at Liuho, north of the capital, and on the Phi Hli border, between Chin Chow, on the Pekin-Mukden Railway in Manchuria, and Tsayang, in Phi Hli. Chang also claims that his second and fourth armies, which are crossing the Phi Hli border, captured large quantities of munitions.

Civilians Killed. Tien Tsin, Sept. 20.—Shanghaikwan, the border town on the Pekin-Mukden Railway, was shelled on Friday morning, according to a corresponding several civilians being killed or injured. Appeals have been made to the British and United States consuls to protest against the shelling of civilians.
