Buenos Aires, Feb. 8.— (Associated Press, by mail.) — Wireless telephone communication between Buenos Aires and Paris is a promise of the not distant future. The government has granted a concession to the General Wireless Telegraph Company of Paris to construct on the Argentine coast a powerful radio-telegraph and radio-telephone station to communicate with France and other European countries. The company, it is said, expects to establish telephone connection with Paris by a system of continuous waves of 800 kilowat power and over.

The duration of the concession is for thirty years. It authorizes the company to carry on experiments in long-distance radio telephony and if at the end of three years the experiments are considered by the Argentine government satisfactory, the concession will be extended to permit commercial exploitation of wireless telephone as well as telegraph communication. Three plants are to be erected, according to the plans.
