London, June 3—(Canadian Press)—None of the delegates to the imperial conference would discuss a report current here two days ago that the body had voted in favor of complete naval autonomy for Canada, Australia and New Zealand but that no definite action has been taken as the inference to be drawn from the delegates who on being asked if the conference had acted upon the matter, replied: "My lips are sealed by a pledge, therefore I can neither affirm nor deny the report. I cannot even discuss the matter now."
