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STATEMENT BY THE ACCUSED (Cont'd)

For the test, it came to my knowledge that I was not sure about all the tools. The Vesper stock and dies which I noticed in the plumbing shop, I had never used on city street and so therefore, I was going to study it. Due to the fact that I had intentions of returning them the following morning, I had left them intact in the box. When I was apprehended by L. Cpl Jolly of the C Pro C and taken to the RSM's office and when the RSM questioned me, I was so shocked by being caught that I told him the first story that entered my head. Had I had any intentions of stealing the stock and dies, I would not have left them in the box.
