

- Q. 10 Do you remember Thursday evening, the 29th. of April, this year?
- A. 10 I do.
- Q. 11 What were you doing early Thursday evening, April 29th?
- A. 11 I was playing ball.
- Q. 12 In what field?
- A. 12 In the Army place at Rockhead.
- Q. 13 Did you see Gunner Gracie there?
- A. 13 Yes Sir.
- Q. 14 Do you see him present in this Court?
- A. 14 Yes Sir.
- Q. 15 Can you point him out to us?
- A. 15 He is there in the middle. (The witness pointed to the accused).
- Q. 16 What took place between you and Gunner Gracie that evening?
- A. 16 We were playing ball at Rockhead and I saw Gunner Gracie, the accused, in the window.
- Q. 17 What took place then?
- A. 17 (No Answer).
- Q. 18 After you saw Gunner Gracie, did anybody ask you if you wanted a bottle of beer, did they Frank?
- A. 18 I asked him for it.
- Q. 19 Did he give it to you?
- A. 19 Yes Sir.
- Q. 20 Who else was present at that time?
- A. 20 Earle McFee, Kenny Cooper, Jimmy White and Bobbie White.
- Q. 21 How many bottles of beer were there?
- A. 21 He gave Earle McFee and me one and then he gave us two more and we took it across the Street.
- Q. 22 After you took it across the street, what happened?
- A. 22 We gave it to Earle McFee's Cousin, and she gave us a half dollar and we took it to Gunner Gracie and he did not want it and we dropped it in his pocket.
- Q. 23 After you dropped it in his pocket, did he give it back to you?
- A. 23 No Sir. He did not know we gave it to him.
